Peschaud Gabon provided the following services to Exterran International SA for the construction phase execution of the Shell Gabon Koula PPF Project :

1. Material loading in port and transfer to barge facilities
2. Barge services for material logistics to and from site jetty location. Approximately 90 return cycles were performed during the project schedule.
3. Crew boat service providing daily transfer of personnel using 20 seater vessels
4. On site crane services
5. Provision of serviced 4WD vehicles

Peschaud undertook these services under the control of HSE guidelines and procedures, including detailed journey management plans. The project achieved over 2.5MM LTI free manhours with personnel logistics being identified as one of the highest risk factors of the project. The crew boat journey is in excess of 6 hours on the open river system in Gabon, Peschaud successfully operated this service without serious incident ensuring personnel welfare at all times.

Equipment handling included single pieces almost 70T in weight. Peschaud provided lifting procedures, lifting arrangements and job hazard analysis for each major lift. No incidents or damage resulted from Peschaud's involvement in material handling.

Peschaud provided a consistent and effective service for the life of the construction phase of the project. During this phase they invested in new equipment providing greater level of flexibility and added value to the service provided. Peschaud are very well adapted to working in the challenging environments offered in African countries.
